Authors are invited to send one copy of extended abstract of the paper. Experts will review the abstract and the selected authors will be asked to submit full length paper as per following specifications.

Paper Size : A4, maximum six pages with one side print

Paper Title : Times 14-pt bold, centered, leave two blank lines after the title

Author Names : beneath the title; Times 12-pt, not bold. Multiple authors may be shown in a two- or three-column format with their affiliations below their respective names.

Author address/Affiliations/email : centered below each author name, italicized 11-pt, not bold. leave two blank lines before main text.

Abstract (the Word) Times 12-pt bold , centered relative to the column, initially capitalized,

Abstract text : italic 10-pt not bold, single-spaced , fully-justified , Max 150 words

keywords : Max 8 keywords, Times 10 Pt not bold **Heading (1st)**: Times 12-pt bold, initially capitalized, left justified, with one blank line before, and one blank line after. Use a period (".") after the heading number, not a colon

Heading 2nd : same as heading 1st except Times 11 pt

Text : 10-pt Times, single-spaced,fully justified,All text must be in a two-column format. Columns are to be 3-1/4 inches (8.25 cm) wide, with a 5/16 inch (0.8 cm) space between them.

Figures and tables must be numbered separately. e.g. "Figure 1. Database contexts", "Table 1. Input data". Figure captions are to be below the figures. Table titles are to be centered above the tables

References: 9-pt Times, single-spaced in alphabetical order e.g. [1] A.B. Smith, C.D. Jones, and E.F. Roberts, "Article Title", Journal, Publisher, Location, Date, pp. 1-10.

All graphics,illustrations,pictures should be part of the running text. No footnotes,headers or colored images are allowed
